Rates/Payments

The fee for more than 6 hours is \$25.00 a day.

The fee for 6 hours or less is \$4.00 per hour charged in quarter hour increments.

There is a \$4.00 minimum per day.

Fees will be billed weekly with a weekly statement being handed out on Monday (Tuesday if Monday is a holiday).

Payment for the balance due shown on the weekly statement is due the Friday of that week.

Families that participate in the state Childcare Subsidy program will pay fees according to the authorization of payment sent by the caseworker.

Summer Program Information

There is a \$35.00 summer fee per child to cover activity expenses. This fee includes the cost for activities and bus expenses.

All scheduled field trips are subject to the following: availability of a bus driver and/or a minimum of 4 students in attendance.

There is a 2-day minimum per week/\$50.00 minimum per week per child for the summer months (mid-May thru mid-August).
