



PK Trinity Tiger Supply List

Dear Parents, Listed below are the supplies your child will need to begin PK. Please label the items with your child's name and bring the supplies on your child's first day of school. (*We appreciate it*)

- 1 change of clothes including socks in a labeled ziplock bag(*incase of milk, water or paint spill*)
- 1 blanket for rest time and a snuggle **OR** pillow
- 1 small water bottle
- 1 box of glue sticks
- 2-3 Pictures of your Family (*We place around the room for children to see*)
- 1 Backpack: Large enough for a folder & lunch box (*my friends are less frustrated when there is only 1 zipper on the bookbag*)
- 1 Folder: with bottom pockets only (*for bringing home papers*)
- 1 Box of Washable Markers: 8-10 count
- 3 Facial Tissues
- 4 Clorox Wipes
- 1 Box Quart Size Zipper Bags

Wear Well Fitted Sneakers Daily for safe running, climbing, the gym and other playground equipment. (*Boots are hard on our gym floor and fingers and Wood Chips get stuck between the feet and sandals-Very Painful!*)

>The Preschool classes do not follow the K-8 dress code.

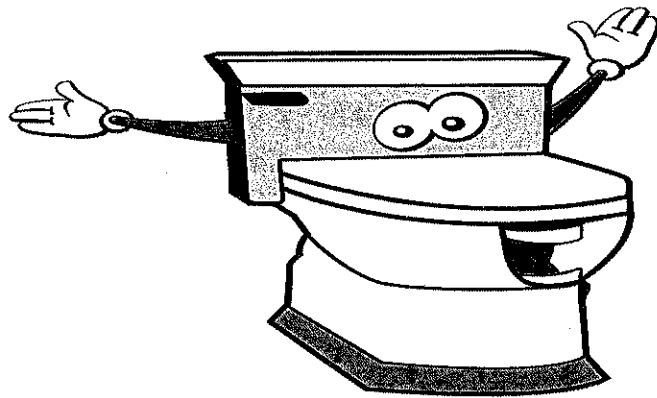
>We **do** go outside in the morning (*when there is still a chill in the air*), a **jacket** is a must and shorts or leggings under a dress.

What is considered potty trained for preschool?



The independence of a “potty-trained” child is a prerequisite for Pre-school.

Independence means that the child must have the awareness to use the bathroom without reminders, be able to manage his/her clothing without help and have the ability to wipe or clean themselves appropriately to maintain clean hygiene.
